Science: Inventors

- To identify differences, similarities or changes related to simple scientific ideas and processes by finding out about the men and women who introduced new plants to our gardens. (William Smith)
- To explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant by exploring the way that non-native plants have been discovered, transported and introduced.
- To find out about the way new plants arrived in our country.
- To identify changes related to scientific ideas by describing Marie Curie's research into x-rays.
- To identify that humans have skeletons for support, protection and movement by identifying and explaining the bones shown in x-rays.
To explain how Marie Curie's work on x-rays helps us identify bones.
