History - Ancient Greeks

INTENT

To know about Ancient Greek life, achievements and their influence on the western world.

- To develop increasingly secure chronological knowledge.
- To use correct terminology to describe events in the past.
- To develop appropriate subject terminology (civilisation, empire, legacy, democracy, city state)

Science Electricity (blocked in science week)

INTENT

- To identify common appliances that run on electricity
- To construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers
- To identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit, based on whether or not the lamp is part of a complete loop with a battery
- To recognise that a switch opens and closes a circuit and associate this with whether or not a lamp lights in a simple series circuit
- To recognise some common conductors and insulators, and associate metals with being good conductors
- To recognise renewable and non-renewable sources of electricity and how electricity reach our homes

DT

To design and build an ancient Greek temple

To investigate and analyse a range of existing products in the context of: looking at existing free-standing structures;

To apply their understanding of how to strengthen, stiffen and reinforce more complex structures in the context of strengthening, reinforcing and stabilising paper tubes and art straws

To select from and use a wider range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks (for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing), accurately in the context of: joining paper/card tubes accurately together; developing practical skills

To select from and use a wider range of materials and components according to their functional properties and aesthetic qualities in the context of selecting and using materials and components to make a temple

To evaluate their ideas against their own design criteria and consider the views of others to improve

INTENT
