We expect that parents will support the principle of homework and it is expected that all children will complete homework set.

There may be occasions when this has not been possible and when this has been the case please liaise with the class teacher.

Holidays

There will be occasions when homework will be set during the school holidays. However if families are away it is understood that children may not have the time to complete set work. Children taking holidays in school term time will not be given extra homework.

It is not envisaged that children should spend an unreasonable length of time on homework. If parents find that children are struggling to finish the set work within a reasonable time it is understood that parents, while supportive of the principle of homework, may take the decision that their child need not necessarily finish all the homework; though it may be finished to an extended deadline.
