Dear Parents,

As part of our local history work, Year 5 are planning to visit Manchester City Art Gallery.

Our visit is going to help us find out more about Manchester's Victorian past. We will spend time looking at the architecture of the building, which was built in the early 1800s and reflects important events in the city's history. We will tour the art works spending time to look in more detail at specific points.

To develop the children's local knowledge further, we will be taking the train into Manchester, leaving Hazel Grove station after 9.30am (avoiding the rush hour) and returning before home time. On arrival at Piccadilly station, the children will walk to the art gallery in supervised groups.

The cost of the trip will be £3.83 (payable via ParentPay) and children will need to bring a packed lunch on the day. If your child usually has free school meals, they will be provided with a lunch. If we do not get enough funds then the trip will have to be cancelled.

We will take the return train to Hazel Grove and arrive before the end of the school day.
