The Year 6 Team

The Year 6 teachers are as follows:

- 6L – Mrs Hewson (LKS2 Phase Leader and Music Lead) – To teach Y6L Wednesday Morning.
- 6C – Miss Carding (Science Lead)

Miss Newton and Mrs Molyneux will be the Teaching assistants working closely with your children.

Reading

- 1 individual book banded reading book to be recorded in the child's Homework/Reading Record
- Children to record the date, book title and pages read daily in their Homework/Reading Record
- We encourage you to record in your child's Homework/Reading Record each time you read with them
- Your child will have the opportunity to read with their teacher each week
- Children may read another book of their choice alongside their book banded book

Home Learning

- The purpose of home learning is to consolidate and extend learning
- Children will be able to complete tasks independently but may be supported
- Children will record their home learning tasks for the week with their teacher in their Homework/Reading Record (this will help them get 'high school ready')
- Any concerns with the home learning should be shared with the class teacher

School Uniform

- You must wear the correct school uniform at all times (please read school uniform policy)
- No jewellery to be worn and if your child wears earrings, small studs only.
- No trainers unless all black without a logo.

PE

- Your child's main PE day is Thursday.
- Children are to come into school in their PE kit.
- The PE kit must be black shorts and a plain white tee shirt. In colder weather they will be allowed to wear black jogging bottoms and a black jumper/hoodie.
